**46. The Chairman's opening remarks.**

The Chairman welcomed all present.

**47. Annual Audit:**

i The Clerk delivered to the Council the Internal Auditors reports for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2007.

ii The Councillors read the reports and agreed the annual governance statement.

iii The Annual Return ( ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2007 ) was signed by the Chairman and co-signed by the Clerk.

**48. Football Stadium at Fossetts and Training Grounds/Carpark in Sutton.**

i The Parish Council have sent information and reports to the Planning Inspectorate re: the Public Local Enquiry, sitting on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2007 enquiring into the above.

These include all of the original Parish Council consultation comments:

i 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2006 ( prior to a public meeting of 10<sup>th</sup> November 2006 ) re: planning application Football Stadium on Fossetts

ii 9<sup>th</sup> January 2007 re: planning application for Training Grounds/Carpark in Sutton

iii the further comments ( 24<sup>th</sup> August 2007 ) on the modifications to Training Grounds/Carpark in Sutton re: the levels, lighting and Flood attenuation pond.

ii 'A brief guide to Planning Inquiries' was recorded.

iii Development Control Committee Minutes re: modifications to Smithers Chase 06/00943/FUL application following the PC consultation comments and Ward Councillor Mr Robin Allen's comments at the meeting on behalf of the PC Quote:

i 'The application is considered deficient in detail in terms of the sustainable drainage information required to support the claim that development would not affect flooding.

ii The revised increase in land levels across the site and likely day content of deposited material is likely to lead to an increased risk of flooding

iii The revised increase in land levels is likely to have an adverse impact in respect of light pollution from the light sources proposed to be installed on the raised levels'.

iv The above members views be relayed to the Inspector at the forthcoming Public enquiry were recorded.

v After discussion it was agreed that all of the above information was the Parish Council case for the rejection of the Football Stadium on Fossetts and Training Grounds/Carpark in Sutton.

vi Councillors will visit the Inspection proceedings from the 25<sup>th</sup> September 2007 and report back.
